Did you know?

Return to work programs benefit employers and employees. It has been proven that if an employer lacks a return to work program, a typical employee is off work for 75 days.

If an employee is off work more than 12 weeks following an injury, close to half of the employees will not return. If they are off work more than a year, less than 3% will return to work.

Employees are happier if they continue to be part of the team. This is true even if the employee is unable to work full time or is temporarily performing different duties.

It also increase the relations and communications between the company and the employee.

Implementing a return to work program can help control a company's experience modification which controls premiums. It also has been shown to reduce lawsuits.
